Young people learn to play and write 12-bar Blues, with a view to the history of the Blues as a means of self discovery and self expression.

LEARN THE UKULELE —
WRITE AND PLAY THE BLUES

Under the guidance of experienced educator/performers, children ages 9 to 12 years learn about the Blues, its roots in slavery and emancipation, and its role in the struggle of a people for dignity and respect. They learn the chords of the Blues on the ukulele (provided) and write two Blues songs, which they'll record in a local studio.

Rosy Cervantes is a renowned Mexican singer songwriter and recording artist, who is also an established Counsellor in Psychology.
